- Respect the rights, dignity and worth of all participants regardless of their age, gender, ability, cultural background or religion
- Play by the rules of the game
- Participate for your own enjoyment and benefit as well as that of your team
- Give your best at all times
- Be fair, considerate and honest in all dealings with others
- Treat all participants how you would like to be treated
- Never argue with an official - if you need clarification, have your captain, coach or manager approach the official during a break or after the competition
- Be a good sport - applaud all good plays whether they are made by your team or the opposition
- Show respect to and acknowledge opponents and officials - (eg. introduce yourself before your game and shake hands or tap rackets after the game and say, 'thanks for the game')
- Play fair and control your temper - no verbal abuse, sledging of other players (including vilification) or deliberately distracting or provoking an opponent will be tolerated
